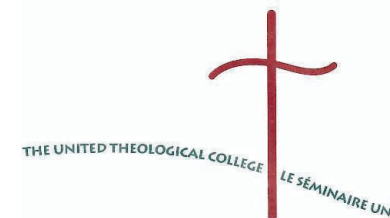

*"That the United States has become an empire is almost conventional wisdom. This is sometimes taken as a new political fact but for Christians it invites a renewed reflection on the context of our faith and spirituality. There is no better time or place in which to become followers of Christ. We will experience the blessings of our faith if we also assume the burdens of this time and place. Here and now, life is more than just grinding on, grinning and bearing it. Life in the midst of a colony of empire can be lived with spirit, with gratitude and joy."*

Mary Jo Leddy received her doctorate in the area of philosophy of religion at the University of Toronto, and is an adjunct professor at Regis College. She was the founding editor of *The Catholic New Times* newspaper and is active in various human rights and peace groups. She has lectured nationally and internationally and is a frequent radio and TV commentator.

Dr. Leddy is the Director of Romero House Community for Refugees and her numerous awards and scholarships include The Governor General's Bronze Medal, the Canadian University President's Award "Outstanding Woman of 1978", the Ida Nudel Human Rights Award, The Canadian Council of Christians and Jews Human Relations Award and, most recently, the Order of Canada.

Dr. Leddy is also the recipient of five honorary doctorates.

*"The Gospel of Matthew aims at nothing less than creating an alternative community of faith and justice in a time of cultural confusion and ethnic conflict. As such, it is a Gospel truly for our historical moment. In this workshop, we will explore Matthew's Gospel with an eye to Christian preaching that is alert to the text and responsive to the needs of our time. Special attention will be given to key texts that appear in the lectionary for the upcoming church year, but the workshop is aimed at all preachers who seek to tap the power of this provocative Gospel."*

Dr. Long is the Bandy Professor of Preaching at Candler School of Theology at Emory University in Atlanta, GA. He received his BA and MDiv from Erskine Theological Seminary and his doctorate from Princeton Theological Seminary in 1980. He is ordained in the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.).

In 1996, Dr. Long was named one of the twelve most effective preachers in the English speaking world by Baylor University, along with the likes of Billy Graham and Barbara Brown Taylor.

Dr. Long's research interests are homiletics and biblical preaching. He is also doing research on the theology and practice of Christian funerals. He is the author/editor of fourteen books on preaching and worship.
